Stormwater Board Discourages Dumping

Did you know that dumping oil, antifreeze, and auto batteries pollute our streams and make monitoring and treatment of our drinking water more difficult and costly? B&C Auto Parts has partnered with the Floyd County Solid Waste Management District to accept these items for recycling. The items must be properly prepared prior to drop-off at B&C Auto Parts. Motor oil must be in a clean, sealable container, like a milk jug. Oil filters should be removed when the engine is warm and placed in a leak proof plastic bag. Used antifreeze should be put in a milk jug or a two liter bottle. Please reuse containers, the containers can no longer be used for other materials after they have hauled oil or antifreeze.
